Distinctive Features

Extra-curricular Activities

Cultural Activities: The college conducts cultural extravaganza "SAGAR SANGAMAM" where several competitions are conducted at the collegiate and intramural level.

Students Seminar: The college hosts state level, inter-collegiate and inter-class seminars in varied subjects.

Journals: The college publishes "MUTHU CHITHARAL" a Tamil Magazine and "VIDHYA VARDHINI" an English Magazine to tap the creative journalistic skills of the students.

Sports and Games: The college has basket ball, volley ball, ball badminton and Shuttle courts. Special training for talented students is given in several outdoor games.

N.S.S.: The college has 3 N.S.S. units and a red ribbon club. It has conducted a blood donation camp, and has taken up social and community work in the villages adopted by the college.

N.C.C.: One NCC army wing unit with 54 cadets is sanctioned to our college and this is functioning from the academic year 2008-09.

Youth Red Cross: Aspects regarding clean environment is shared with students through YRC, which was started during the academic year 2007-08.

Karuna Club: This club is engaged in bringing out an awareness of the environmental problems and to be compassionate towards animals.

Rotaract Club: The college Rotaract Club imparts volunteer service in the minds of the students.

Special Facilities

College Buses: The college operates a fleet of buses for the easy transportation of students from different points in and around Chengalpattu at a nominal cost.

Internet Club: The college has a good access to internet. Students are welcome to become members of this club.

Book Bank: Each department runs a book bank for the benefit of students who cannot afford to buy text books.

College Cafeteria: The college cafeteria is spacious, well ventilated and provides nutritious vegetarian food at reasonable prices.

Accident Cover: A compulsory group insurance scheme of accident cover is provided for students at a premium of Rs.100/- p.a.

U.G.C. Programme: The students have access to colour television set to watch country-wide classroom programmes of the UGC.





Teachers, Training & Technology

Excellent Academic Training: Academic excellence can be achieved through the right perspective of both the student and the teacher. Continuous evaluation of the students is done by the teachers. Parent-Teachers meetings are organized to enable parent participation in the monitoring mechanism. Slow learners are given special attention through retests and counseling.

Innovative Teaching Methodology: To sustain the interest of the students and make learning process more meaningful and productive, the new teaching techniques such as role play, case study, group discussion, peer teaching, quiz, brainstorming, audio-visual presentation, assignments and class seminars are introduced.



Student Support Schemes

Student Counseling Forum: The system has proved to be very effective in establishing a more meaningful rapport between the students and the staff.

Scholarship and proficiency prize: The college offers a number of scholarships to the deserving students. The students are also encouraged to apply for scholarships offered by the government. The most proficient students of each class are awarded a gold medal or prize at the end of every academic year.

Language Laboratory: Workshop on communication skill in English is conducted for all the first year students. Students are trained to acquire and sharpen essential language skills in reading, writing, speaking, listening and creative thinking.

Personality Development Programme: The first year students are trained in various skills like team work, time management, creative thinking, accepting responsibility, problem solving skills, stress management and confidence building.

Placement Cell: In order to endow our final year students with a bright future, we have established a Placement Cell.





Rules Governing Admission

How to apply

Application from eligible candidates made in the prescribed form only are considered.

Candidates must fill the application legibly and in their own handwriting.

Separate applications must be used for each course. The applicants must read the instructions carefully and make sure that they are eligible to the course they are applying for, as per the University requirements.

Application forms are issued in the name of the candidate seeking admission and are not transferable.

Candidates and their parents are solely responsible for the declarations made in the application form. If, at any time, it is found that the particulars given are inaccurate or incomplete the student shall forfeit her seat.

Completed applications can be posted or delivered at the office within 10 days from the date of the publication of the results of the qualifying examinations conducted in Tamilnadu. Applicants from other states where the results have not been announced can still send their form filled, except the result column, within the deadline. But they must submit their marks within a reasonable time.

The candidates are advised to send their application forms well in advance to avoid any postal delay.

Late or incomplete applications, and those giving false information will be summarily rejected.

There is no need to affix photograph or enclose copies of mark sheets etc., at the time of applying unless asked for. They must be submitted at the time for scrutiny.

Accompanying Documents

The candidates must affix sufficient stamps and mention their address on the acknowledgement card if they desire it to be posted.

Marks certificate will be verified by the Director of the Government Examinations. If found bogus, admission will be cancelled and also criminal proceedings will be initiated.

Selected candidates have to produce three passport size photographs of good quality, mark sheets, transfer and conduct certificates and any other documents that may be required by the college in original at the time of admission. The parent or guardian must accompany the candidate at the time of interview.

Applicant passing AISC/CBSE/ISC examination with a minimum of five subjects, including English as compulsory subject need not obtain the prior eligibility certificate from the University of Madras. They shall, however remit Rs.100/- to the college office at the time of admission towards recognition fees. All other candidates in respect of other school board examinations, both Indian and foreign, shall obtain the prior eligibility certificate from the University of Madras.

Selected candidates are advised to keep copies of the certificates required, as the originals will be returned only at the end of the course.

Admission Intimation

There is absolutely no need to solicit information about selection. A provisional admission card will be mailed to the selected candidates specifying the time for interview. The receipt of the card by itself does not guarantee admission. Extension of time will not be granted under any circumstances. Rejected applicants will not be intimated.

If a candidate admitted into a course abstains from classes for five or more days continuously her name will be removed from the rolls and the fees paid will not be returned.

Candidates proficient in sport at State or National level and other extra curricular activities shall be given preference for admission.
